

PRIVACY NOTICE IUPAC|CHAINS2023

INTRODUCTION CONTROLLERS

This is a joint privacy notice ("Privacy Notice") pursuant to article 26 of the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR") (regulation (EU) 2016/679) that is applicable to the joint activities of the following two parties:

- a. FOUNDATION IUPAC 2023 ("KNCV"), having its registered office at Loire 150, 2491 AK in The Hague (Chamber of Commerce number: 71775072. KNCV can be contacted via its Data Protection Officer at hcloosterman@kncv.nl;
- b. the Dutch Research Council ("NWO"), established at Laan van Nieuw Oost-Indië 300, 2593 CE The Hague. NWO can be contacted via its Data Protection Officer at fg@nwo.nl;

The Data Protection Officer of KNCV shall serve as the first point of contact under this Privacy Notice.

The aforementioned two parties shall individually be referred to as "Joint Controller" and "we" or "us" refers to both parties jointly. We jointly determine the purposes and means of processing of your personal data relating to IUPAC|CHAINS2023. Via this Privacy Notice, we inform you of the essence of the arrangements between us and provide you with transparency as to how we will process your personal data for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice.

This Privacy Notice applies separately from any privacy statements KNCV and NWO may individually have in place in regard to individual processing of your personal data. This Privacy Notice addresses the situation where we are joint controllers of your personal data in the context of IUPAC|CHAINS2023.

1. PERSONAL DATA WE PROCESS

We will process the following personal data of the following data subjects:

Data Subjects:

Participants of the chemistry congress IUPAC|CHAINS2023, including general participants, speakers, sponsors, invited guests, (co)-organizers and employees of both Parties.

Data Categories:

Name, Email address, Gender, Telephone number, Affiliation, Profession, position, Expertise and professional interests, Diet wishes, Mailing address, postal code, city, country, home address, Online identifiers: IP-address and credentials.

The processing of these personal data of above data subjects is necessary to fulfil the purposes referred to in section 2.

Sources of personal data

The personal data described in this Privacy Notice are collected through the registration system on the [iupac2023](http://iupac2023.com) website. In addition, NWO and KNCV have collected personal data from, respectively, previous editions of NWO CHAINS and the KNCV database. These personal data will be shared between the Joint Controllers for the purpose of organizing IUPAC|CHAINS2023.

Provision to third parties

We shall not share your personal data with third parties, unless this is required to satisfy legal obligations we are subject to, or if it is required to carry out the organization of IUPAC|CHAINS2023. If we supply your personal data to a third party, we will make adequate arrangements to ensure that your data will not be used for any other purposes and will be deleted as soon as they are no longer needed. Third party recipients of this privacy notice concern the service providers engaged by the Joint Controllers. KNCV has contracted Congress by design B.V., having its registered offices at Kloosterweg 6C, 3481 XC Harmelen, the Netherlands, registered at the Chamber of Commerce Amsterdam under number 52474887 as the provider of congress management services for the chemistry congress IUPAC|CHAINS 2023.

2. BASIS AND PURPOSES OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

We process your personal data based on the legitimate interest of the Parties to jointly organize the chemistry congress IUPAC|CHAINS from 20-25 August 2023.

We will only use the personal data referred to in section 1 for the following purposes: participant registration, informing (future) participants about the congress, managing the program and lunches, booking of accommodations and travel.

3. RETENTION PERIOD FOR PERSONAL DATA

Personal data processed in the context of IUPAC|CHAINS2023 will be retained no longer than necessary for the organization of the congress, unless one or more of the Joint Controllers are obliged to process the personal data for their individual processing purposes (i.e. to fulfil a legal obligation). Such individual processing shall be subject to the individual retention periods maintained by these individual Joint Controllers.

4. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

Under the GDPR you have a number of important rights, including:

- Right to access: You may request a summary about the personal data we process about you at any time.
- Correcting or supplementing your data (rectification): If there are errors or omissions in the personal data held by us about you, you may submit a request for rectification.
- Deleting your personal data (right to be forgotten): In certain circumstances, you may request that we delete your data from our systems. We cannot delete your data in situations where we process your personal data in furtherance of our statutory obligations.
